



ICPC Asia West Continent Finals 2022: Celebrating Success, Fostering Innovation

For the second time in the history of the Asia West Continent, **Ghulam Ishaq Khan Institute of Engineering Sciences and Technology (GIKI)** and **ICPC Asia Topi**, Pakistan, took the lead in organizing the highly anticipated ICPC Asia West Continent Finals. This thrilling 5-hour long programming showdown pushed the limits of our four exceptional teams that represented Pakistan in the contest, embarking on an intense competition alongside 24 teams from Bangladesh and 33 teams from India. The multi-site contest spanned across three prestigious international locations, simultaneously: **Dhaka, Bangladesh; Mathura, India; and Topi, Pakistan.**

The International Collegiate Programming Contest (ICPC) is renowned as the "**World Cup of Computing**," attracting the best minds from universities worldwide to showcase their problem-solving, programming, and teamwork skills. With participation from over **3,322+ universities in 111 countries** across **six continents**, ICPC has become the ultimate platform for algorithmic programming excellence.

The ICPC Asia West Continent Finals welcomed teams from countries including India, Pakistan, Bangladesh, Iran, and others. The contest unfolded on the **19th and 20th of May 2023**, with a mock round held on the first day and a final contest taking place on the second. The Inaugural Session of the event commenced in India, whereas participants from Pakistan and Bangladesh joined the session online through Zoom. The contest was simultaneously conducted at these three international sites.

A total of **61 teams** representing Pakistan, India, and Bangladesh competed for top honors. Pakistan was proudly represented by teams from **GIK Institute, FAST-NUCES Karachi, FAST-NUCES Islamabad, and Punjab University College of Information Technology, Lahore.**

The final contest witnessed exceptional performances from all participants. **Indian Institute of Technology (IIT), Kanpur** secured the coveted first prize, followed closely by **IIT, Kharagpur** in second place, and **IIT, Madras** in third. India dominated the scoreboard,



displaying exceptional programming prowess. **Bangladesh University of Engineering and Technology** achieved an impressive 7th rank. While Pakistan still has room for improvement, we are yet proud of the progress made by our teams this year. Their determination and hard work have yielded notable accomplishments.

Notably, **Team AC47** from **GIKI** filled us with pride by solving four challenging problems and securing a respectable 36th rank. **Team Cypher** from **FAST-NUCES, Karachi** showcased their skills by solving three problems. These achievements illustrate the significant strides Pakistan has made since the previous year. We remain determined to further motivate our students, fostering a culture of problem-solving and coding excellence that will soon propel Pakistan up the leaderboard.

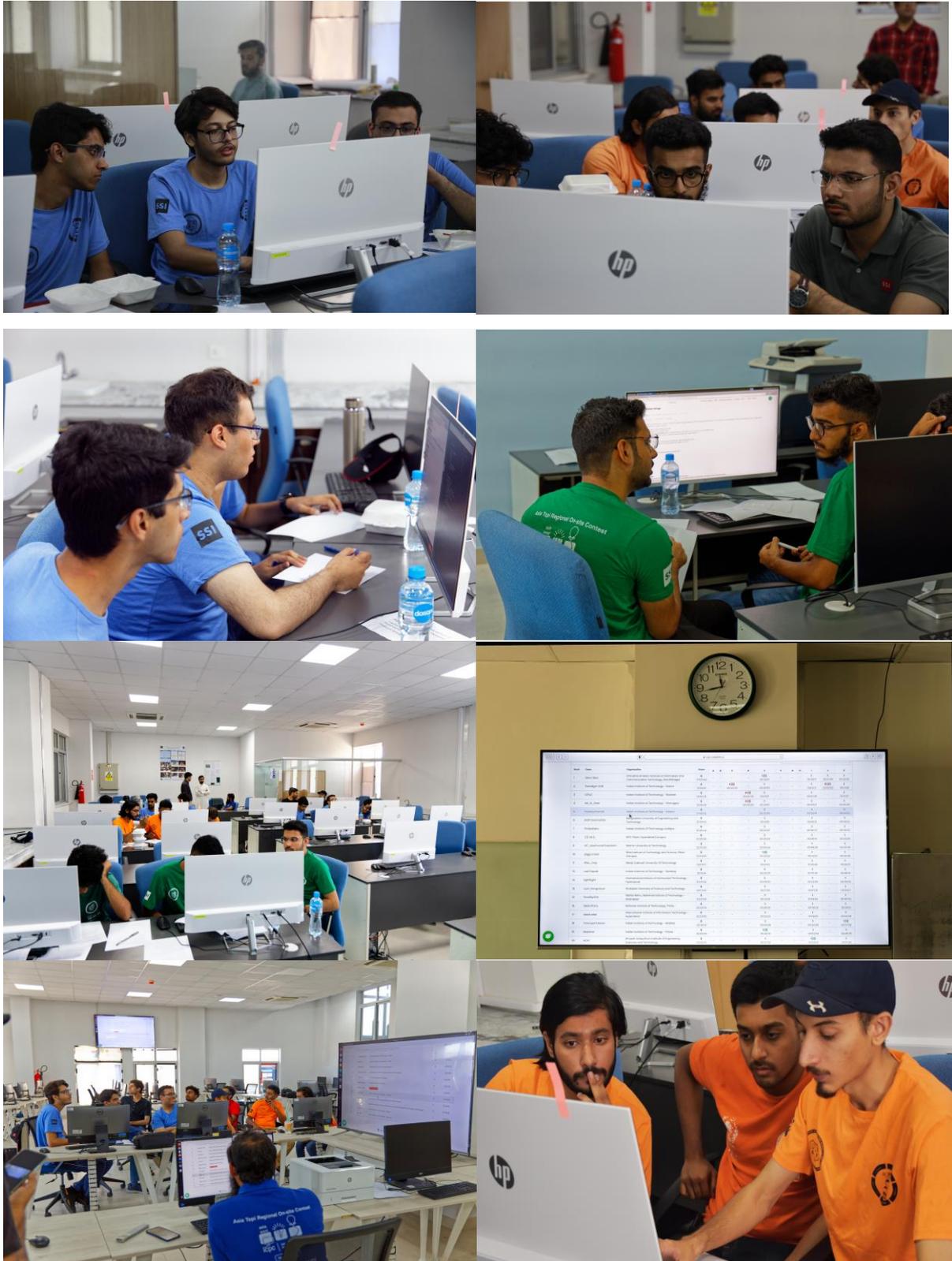

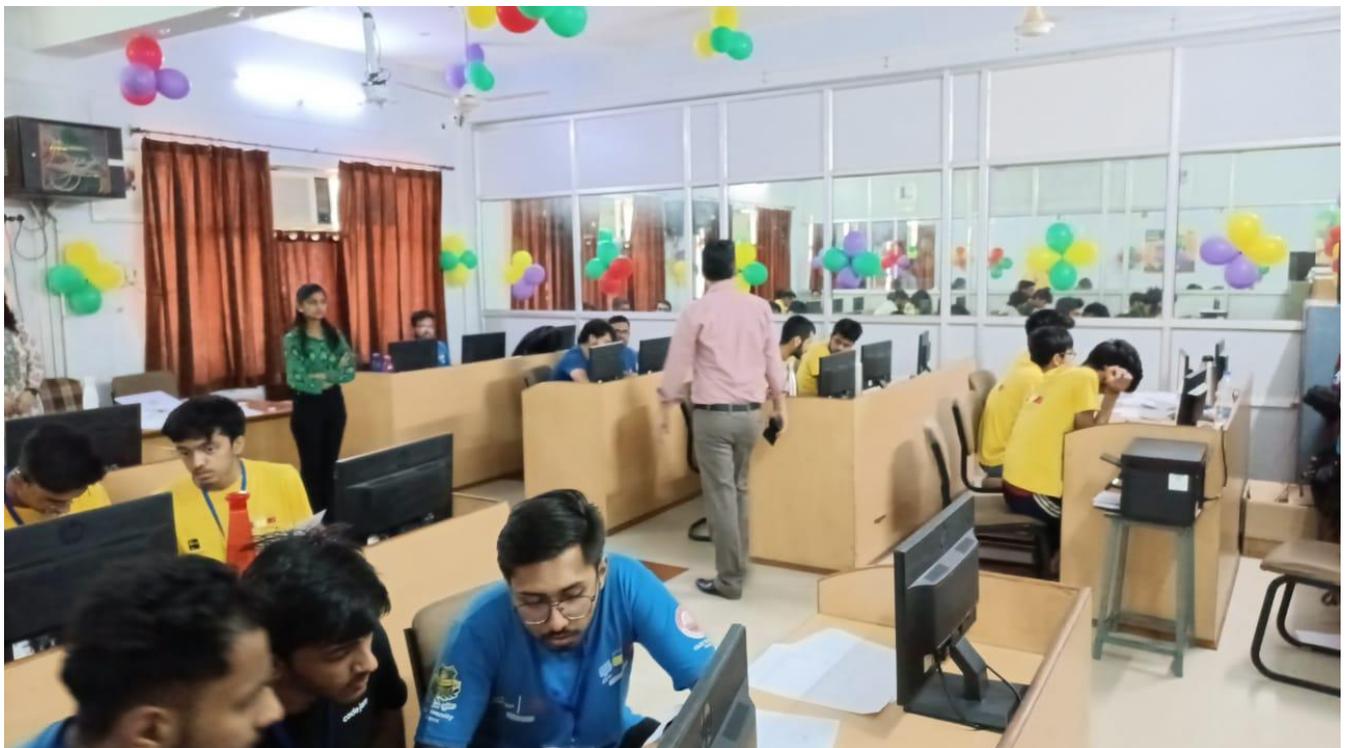
